



2016 JICARILLA WATERFOWL HUNTING RULES AND INFORMATION

Season Dates: October 08—November 30, 2016

GENERAL REGULATIONS: General Hunting Regulations are provided in the 2016-17 Hunting Proclamation(s); specific waterfowl hunting regulations are provided below:

- Shooting hours: One-half hour before sunrise, to sunset
- Non-toxic shot only
- Shotguns only, 20 gauge minimum
- Camping is permitted at Stone Lake, Enbom Lake, Mundo Lake, La Jara Lake and Enbom Lake
- Camping is free with a valid Jicarilla waterfowl hunting or Jicarilla fishing permit

LICENSE INFORMATION:

- 2016 Jicarilla waterfowl hunting licenses are only sold at the Jicarilla Game and Fish Department Office, located at 38 Airport Road, Dulce NM. Please contact JGFD at least 7-business days prior to hunt to arrange for permits through mail.
- License Fees: (see proclamation) Non Member: \$20 day / \$100 Season
- A valid Federal Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation Stamp (Duck Stamp) is required for all hunters 16 years of age and older, available from the U.S. Post Office, and NMDGF
- A Jicarilla Wildlife Stamp is not required for waterfowl hunters in 2016

LEGAL HUNTING AREAS: All waters on the Jicarilla Apache reservation are open to waterfowl hunting, except Horse Lake and Mundo Lake. Hunting is permitted at the following fishing/recreation lakes: Enbom Lake, Dulce Lake, and Stone Lake only when there are no fishermen present. For maps and additional information please contact the Jicarilla Game and Fish Department at 575-759-3255. Waterfowl hunters must complete a harvest report for the season, which will be provided by JGFD when permits are issued.
