



# 2022 JICARILLA APACHE NATION SPECIAL WATERFOWL HUNTING REGULATIONS

Season Dates: October 8—November 30, 2022



**REGULATIONS** Established by the Jicarilla Apache Nation apply as provided below. Refer to respective 2022 Hunting Proclamation(s) for additional general hunting regulations;

1. **SHOOTING HOURS:** one-half hour before sunrise, to sunset
2. **MANNER OF TAKE:** shotguns only, 20 gauge minimum, Non-toxic shot only
3. **GUIDES:** Tribal Member Guides are encouraged but not required for non-member hunters
4. **CAMPING:** is only permitted at Stone Lake, Enbom Lake, and Mundo Lake. Camping is free with a valid Jicarilla hunting or Jicarilla fishing permit
5. **LICENSE INFORMATION:**
  - a. 2022 Jicarilla Waterfowl hunting licenses are only sold at the Jicarilla Game and Fish Department Office, located at 38 Airport Road, Dulce NM. Please contact JGFD at least 7-business days prior to hunt to arrange for permits through mail.
  - b. License Fees: (see proclamation) Non Member: \$20 day / \$100 Season
  - c. Each waterfowl hunter 16 years of age and older must carry on his/her person a valid Federal Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation Stamp (Duck Stamp) signed in ink across the stamp face. Available from the U.S. Post Office.
  - d. A Jicarilla Wildlife Stamp is not required for waterfowl hunters

6. **BAG and POSESSION LIMITS:**

7. **LEGAL HUNTING AREAS:** All waters on the Jicarilla Apache reservation are open to waterfowl hunting, except Horse Lake and Mundo Lake. Hunting is permitted at the following fishing/recreational lakes: Enbom Lake, Dulce Lake, and Stone Lake **only** when there are no fishermen present.
